The notes and bibliography style is one of two citation options provided by the Chicago Manual of Style. Each time a source is quoted or paraphrased, a superscript number is placed in the text, which corresponds to a footnote or endnote containing details of the source.

Chicago Style Paper Example Footnotes - Floss Papers

Sometimes called "Chicago Style," footnotes and endnotes are different from in-text citation methods (such as APA or MLA). Footnotes and endnotes require you to include detailed information about each source as you cite it. With few exceptions, you should use either footnotes or endnotes in your paper, not both.

Footnotes/Endnotes. Footnotes will always appear at the bottom of the page where the reference occurs and endnotes go on a separate page after the body of the paper. Place the note number at the end of the sentence in which the reference occurs and after any punctuation; remember to superscript it.

Paper Formatting - Chicago Style Guide, for 17th Edition ...

The style of Chicago/Turabian we use requires footnotes rather than in-text or parenthetical citations. Footnotes or endnotes acknowledge which parts of their paper reference particular sources. Generally, you want to provide the author's name, publication title, publication information, date of publication, and page number(s) if it is the first time the source is being used.
