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How To Prepare Your Curriculum

Define the purpose of the curriculum. Your curriculum should have clear topic and purpose. The topic should be appropriate for the age of the students and the environment in which the curriculum will be taught. If you are asked to design a course, ask yourself questions about the general purpose of the course.

A curriculum vitae is a longer (two or more pages), more detailed synopsis of your background and skills. As with a resume, you may need different versions of a CV for different types of positions. Like a resume, a curriculum vitae should include your name, contact information, education, skills, and experience.

List in reverse chronological order, starting with your current place of learning. Include the name of the institution, the degree sought or completed, and the date of completion or date of expected completion. Remember to include medical school, graduate education and undergraduate education.

How to Prepare your Curriculum Vitae

Focus on your measurable, relevant achievements, not just your duties. Use action verbs: "created," "analysed," "implemented," not "responsible for creating, analysis and implementation.". Tailor your CV to the job posting—read the job description carefully and check what tasks will be expected of you.

Use your state standards and units listed in your curriculum to write create lessons. Activities do not need to be rigidly structured as they are in grade school. You should, however, create a basic daily routine to follow, as this is helpful to young children. Try to strike a balance between small group, medium group, and whole group activities.
